

RAABO (Regulation) No. AN V
0081/FP/SAN/CAPRO/DP
February 29, 1988 concerning the
regulation of advertising and places
for tobacco consumption.

TEXT ENTERS INTO FORCE
FEBRUARY 29, 1988

TOBACCO
ADVERTISING AND CONSUMPTION

Article 1. Advertising for tobacco, cigarettes, cigars and cigarillos is prohibited on displays and billboards.

Article 2. It is prohibited to smoke in the following places:

- Meeting rooms or conference rooms;
- Classrooms for vocational or theoretical instruction;
- Eating places;
- Enclosed movie theaters;
- Service stations;
- Sanitary facilities;
- Dormitories
- Government Offices;
- Kindergartens and places where children are accommodated.

Article 3. Manufacturers of monopoly products are required to print on packs, cases, pouches, boxes or other containers:

- The statement: "Monopoly sale in Burkina Faso."
(This statement must also appear on cartons).
- The tar content and nicotine level.
- The following warning:
- "Take care, for your health."

The placement of the warning is left to the discretion of the manufacturers of Monopoly products and tobacco companies. These provisions must become effective within the 6 months following the date of signing of this regulation ('*raabo*').*

Article 5. Infractions of the provisions of this regulation shall be investigated, prosecuted and suppressed in accordance with the law in force.

Article 6. All prior contrary provisions bearing on this matter are hereby rescinded.

Article 7. The Director of Price Control; Regional Directors of Commerce and People's Provisions; the Director of Regulations and of Distribution; the Director of Education on Health and Sanitation; and the Director of Measuring and Control Instruments are charged with the enforcement of this Raabo. The Raabo will be registered, communicated and published everywhere needed.
