PRESS RELEASE

The Government of the Republic of Cameroon, in accordance with the provisions of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control, signed Joint Ministerial Order N°0001/MOPH/MOCOMERCE of 3rd January 2018, laying down the conditions for the packaging and labeling of tobacco products.

With effect from 3rd January 2019, all packets, rolls, masters cases or any others packaging of tobacco products sold in Cameroon shall carry:

1. A general warning, illustrated by picture and covering at least 70% of the "front external surface" of the packaging unit;
2. A specific health warning, illustrated by picture and covering at least 70% of the "rear external surface" of the packaging unit.

Manufacturers and importers of tobacco and tobacco products, including wholesalers and retailers, are responsible for the compliance of their products with the packaging and labeling measures set out by the Joint Ministerial Order.

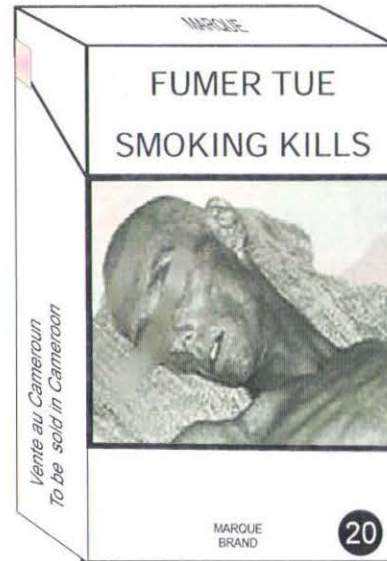
Any offender of this Ministerial Order shall be subject to sanction and penalties as provided by the law and regulations in force.
