MINISTRY OF LABOR, EMPLOYMENT AND HEALTH

Edict of December 1, 2010 establishing the models for signs called for by Article R. 3511-6 of the Code of Public Health

The Minister of Labor, Employment and Health, and the Secretary of State in charge of Health for the Minister of Labor, Employment and Health,

In light of the Code of Public Health, particularly its Articles R. 3511-1, R. 3511-2, R. 3511-6 and R. 3511-8, hereby

Orders:

Art. 1. – Signs stating the prohibition of smoking in the places mentioned in Article R. 3511-1 of the Code of Public Health, and stated in Article R. 3511-6 of this code, are to adhere to the model provided in Annex 1 of this Edict.

However, signs drafted or printed prior to the date of publication of this Edict and in accordance with Annexes 1 or 2 of the Edict of January 22, 2007, are considered to be valid.

Art. 2. – The signs to be posted at the entrance of the spaces mentioned in Article R. 3511-2 of the Code of Public Health are to adhere to the model provided in Annex 2 of this Edict.

Signs drafted or printed prior to the date of publication of this Edict and in accordance with Annex 3 of the Edict of January 22, 2007 are no longer considered valid after a period of three months following the publication of this Edict.

Art. 3. – These signs must adhere to the graphic specifications indicated in Annex 3 of this Edict.

Art. 4. – The Edict of January 22, 2007, establishing the models for signs called for by Article R. 3511-6 of the Code of Public Health is hereby rescinded.

Art. 5. – The Director General of Health is charged with the execution of this Edict, which is to be published in the *Journal officiel* [Official Bulletin] of the French Republic.

These models must be printed as specified, and they must not and cannot under any circumstances be modified.

These models can be printed on any kind of paper, plastic or adhesive surface, etc.

These models must be printed with minimum dimensions of 15 × 21 cm (A5), without restrictions on blowing them up to larger sizes.

The colors and typefaces may not under any circumstances be at variance with the following specifications:
