<p>SUPPORT THE CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE USE OF TOBACCO</p>	<p>In light of the Code of Public Health, particularly its Article L.3511-2-1 and L.3512-1-1 of Law no. 2003-715 dated July 31, 2003, seeking to impede the consumption of tobacco among young people, hereby Decrees:</p>
<p>Enter one or more words, then execute your search by pressing "Enter"</p> <p>[Search]</p>	<p>Article 1</p> <p>The 1st Chapter of the Sole Section of Book V of the Code of Public Health (Regulatory part) is supplemented by a section 3 to read as follows:</p> <p>"Section 3 : Prohibition of the sale of tobacco to minors under sixteen years of age.</p> <p>"Art. D.3511-15. – A notice recalling the provisions of Article L.3511-2-1 is to be placed in public view in the establishments of tobacco retailers, holders of purchase-resale licenses and resellers, mentioned in the first paragraph of Article 568 of the General Tax Code. A copy thereof is to be sent to them for such purpose.</p> <p>"The model of this notice is determined by the edict of the minister in charge of the economy and finance and the minister in charge of health."</p>

Article 2

The sole section of Chapter II of the sole heading of Book V of the third part of the Code of Public Health (Regulatory part) is supplemented by an Article D.3512-3 which is to read as follows:

“Art. D.3512-3 – In application of Article L.3512-1-1, the production of a piece of identification or any other official document with a photograph that shows proof of age of the interested party may be required by the person in charge of sales of tobacco in the establishments mentioned in the first paragraph of Article D.3511-15.”

Article 3

The Minister of State, Minister of the Economy, Finance and Industry, the Minister of the Interior, of Internal Security and Local Liberties, and the Guardian of the Seals, the Minister of Justice, the Minister of Health and Social Protection, the acting Minister of the Interior, spokesman for the Government, and the Secretary of State for the Budget and Budgetary Reform are charged, each within their own domain, with the execution of this decree, which is to be published in the Journal official of the French Republic.
