Monitoring Juveniles Behavior Law (No. 37) 2006.
(Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco) - Ministry of Interior

Article 4 --

A - prohibiting, under criminal responsibility, the following acts: --

1. Sale of tobacco or alcohol or narcotic substances, psychotropic substances to the minors, even if under the prescription with regard to narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, including the ban of sale of volatile substances.
2. Allow the minors to enter nightclubs or bars.
3. Provide alcohol or water pipe to the minors in cafes, restaurants and similar places that offered.

Article 8 --

A - Notwithstanding the provisions of any other legislation, shall be punished by imprisonment term not exceeding six months or a fine not exceeding five hundred dinars, or both penalties

Any person who commits any of the following irregularities: --

1. Sold to the minor tobacco or alcohol or volatile materials or the made the minor buy any of them or distract him a prescription especially with drugs and psychotropic substances.
2. Allowed the minors to enter nightclubs or bars.
3. Provided for the minors, alcohol or water pipe.

B - The penalty is doubled if repeated commission of any of the violations set forth in paragraph (A) of this article.
