implementation of Law No. 2006-12 of May 15, 2006 on tobacco control;

Mindful of Decree N°. 2016-161 / PRN of April 02, 2016, appointing the Prime Minister, Head
of Government;

Mindful of Decree n° 2016-572 / PRN of October 19, 2017, appointing members of Government,
modified by the decree N° 2016/622 of November 14, 2016 and decree N° 2017/289 / PRN of
April 18, 2017;

Mindful of Decree No. 2016-623 / PRN of November 14, 2016, on the organization of the
Government and establishing the powers of Ministers of State, Ministers and Deputy Ministers;

Mindful of Decree N°. 2016-624/PM of November 14, 2016, defining the responsibilities members
of Government;

Mindful of Decree N°. 2016-495/PRN/MC/PSP of December 04, 2013, on the organization of the
Ministry of Trade and Private Sector Promotion;

Upon proposal from the Secretary General,

DECREE:

Article one: The purpose of the present decree is to protect present and future generations from the health effects related to the consumption of other forms of tobacco.

The importation, distribution and sale of shisha or hookah and accessories is prohibited.

Article 2: Any infringement of the provisions of article 1 of the present decree will be punished in accordance with the anti-tobacco law, the Customs Code, the Code of Public Hygiene and any other related regulation.

Article 3: Importers and distributors of shisha or hookah have six months to comply with these regulations.

Article 4: Sworn agents of the Ministry of Trade *and* Private Sector Promotion, customs officers, Sanitary Police officers and Defense and Security Forces are authorized to identify and punish infringements of the provisions of the present decree.

Article 5: The Secretary General of the Ministry of Trade and Private Sector Promotion, the Secretary General of the Ministry of Public Health, the Secretary General of the Ministry of Finance, the Secretary General of the Ministry of the Interior, Public Security, Decentralization and Customary and Religious Affairs are each responsible for the implementation of the present decree which will be published in the official gazette.
