**Concerning the creation of the
Network of Members of Parliament
for tobacco control**

IN LIGHT OF The Constitution of August 9, 1999;

IN LIGHT OF Law No. 97-006 of June 5, 1997, concerning the functioning of the National
Assembly;

IN LIGHT OF Resolution No. 2000-001/NA of January 2, 2000, concerning the Internal
Regulation of the National Assembly;

IN LIGHT OF Law No. 2006-12 of May 15, 2006, concerning tobacco control;

IN LIGHT OF The Minutes of the meeting on April 14, 2007;

Article 1: A Network of Members of Parliament for tobacco control is created within the
National Assembly. Its purpose is as follows:

1. To see to the application of the law for tobacco control;
2. To create a partnership and strengthen a synergy with other players in the
campaign for tobacco control;
3. To inform and raise awareness of members of parliament, opinion leaders and the
general public on the harmful effects of tobacco.

Article 2: The Network of Members of Parliament for tobacco control is directed by a
Board consisting of:

- A President
- A Vice President
- A 1st Rapporteur
- A 2nd Rapporteur
- A General Treasurer
- An Adjunct General Treasurer
